In 2005/6, Audax led the world with the UK Home Office and Devon and Cornwall Police in a joint project that led to the development of the first ever BWV standards.

In recent years we have again led the UK Security Industry as we were the First UK Security SME ever funded by the European Union Research and Innovation H2020 Instrument in a Phase 2 project. This project culminated in March 2018 as Audax hosted The European Union Commissioner for Security - Sir Julian King. At the same time, Audax received the Communications Systems Award at the Counter Terror Business awards.

Audax is headquartered in Plymouth, UK, the Historic Port City where the founders and early settlers of America, Australia and New Zealand all departed on their epic journeys, and from where the first ever Transatlantic flight landed.

Audax continues its global reach with a satellite office located in Brussels, Belgium, which has supported our worldwide customer base with greater efficiency.

We manufacture and design our BWV solutions to be 'Security and Privacy by Design' products. By using a single device (not tethering with a phone) and with the use of AES 256 encryption technology on both the camera and the live stream, we thus meet a higher level of GDPR Privacy compliance than others.

Manufacturing

Audax use contract manufacturers to produce our component subassemblies, which we have had a good relationship with for the past 10 years. Some of these are based in the United Kingdom to further mitigate any supply disruption risk and ensure competitive pricing.

Along with product design and development, we perform all final assembly, testing and quality control functions for these products in our Plymouth facility.

In the case of the camera docking stations, all sub assembly manufacturing for these items takes place in the UK, using tools and moulds owned by us. Parts assembly and unit build/ manufacture is then carried out by us at our site in Plymouth. These critical items make up over 60% of our overall BWV hardware solution and One hundred per cent of labour/human resource that make the finished product carrying the mark, was in Britain at the time the product was first offered for sale. It is why we are approved as **Members of Made in Britain**, the register of British Manufacturers.

Technical Expertise

Due to the complexity of our products, we believe that it is important to maintain a core of knowledgeable production personnel for consistent quality. In addition, such technicians are valuable in our service and repair business to support our growing customer base.
